Basic Drawing I: Drawing from direct observation with an emphasis on space, volume, linear and free hand perspective. **Register by 6/28.**

Clay History—Vishi Garig, Clay County Archivist, will walk us through Clay History.

Computer Training—Joe Pacachek—Computer training will focus on two key aspects of how we use personal computers today – Online use and Offline use. The class will make connections between online and offline use, staying safe, and protecting your computer from "cyber attacks." The class will be taught from a Microsoft Windows perspective, though Apple Mac users will find it equally beneficial.

Flower Arranging—Limit class to 12. Cost per person \$16 paid at first class to Ruth Johansen. Student provides flowers, scissors, clippers. Greenery, container and oasis for designs will be provided. We will learn the Elements of Design and Principles of Design to make 8 floral arrangements. **Register by 6/28.**

Greeting Cards—Pat Fiedler—This class is limited to 10 students and the supply fee is \$20 payable to Pat Fiedler. You will need scissors, glue and pens or pencils to color your cards. **Register by 6/28.**

Jewelry Making—Nancy Keown, 2 hour class, \$40 supply fee paid to Nancy. Beginners are welcome. Supplies needed: Standard Crimper, Chain or Needle Nose Pliers, Round Nose Pliers, and Side Cutters. Quilting—Jean Watson & Lucinda Neweskery—Bring your own sewing machine. Jean and Lucinda will supply the needed materials in a kit. There is a \$40 kit fee, payable to Jean Watson. **Register by 6/28.**

Tangling on Paper—Chris Bass- Tangling is a drawing style that centers on and follows detailed step-by-step instructions for various patterns. The only equipment needed is a black gel pen, a pencil, a Q-tip for shading, and white paper. cut in four pieces. There is no pressure, and no mistakes, just lots of fun and camaraderie. No art experience needed.

Troll Pots using Air Dry Clay: Glass jars covered in clay and painted to become your troll creation. Fun for growing herbs or succulents. All supplies provided for three pots, kits are \$20 payable to JoElla Manning. **Register by 6/28.**
